Not only will we be accepting big band or other jazz compositions with all the parts orchestrated and arranged, but this year we are accepting submissions for compositions that may need arrangement assistance and may only have a few parts to be performed by a small group. Acceptance of compositions will be based on uniqueness, creativity, and artistic impression and will be performed live by Nineteen Jazz Orchestra.

In 2009 Nineteen received over 40 submissions of which 15 were selected and performed live on stage in the Composers Concert.
